<b>Name</b>	<b>CLEANER FOR VENETIAN PLASTER</b>
<b>Description</b>	This product is used to clean smooth lime or cement-based plaster finishes, as well as washable paint finishes. It is also suitable on finishes previously treated with natural protections such as Natural Beeswax. It is designed to remove ordinary dirt, as well as dirt found above radiators or fireplaces. When you wash a wall finished with Venetian plasters, there is the risk that the dirt on the surface penetrates in the stucco together with the water you use to clean it, making it irreparably dirty. Our cleaner keeps the dirt into its foam, preventing it from penetrating.
<b>Composition</b>	Sodium carbonate, softening agents, foaming agents, calcium carbonate, sodium alkyl benzene sulfonate, surfactants.
<b>Appearance</b>	Dense liquid

<b>Packaging</b>	1 kg polyethylene packaging
<b>Application</b>	By hand, using a sponge or cloth

<b>Drying</b>	2 hours at 20°C (60°F) to the touch 24 hours at 20°C (60°F) below the surface

<b>VOC Classification</b>	EU Directive 2004/42/CE: EU limit value for this product (cat A/I): 200 g/l (2010). This product contains less than 200 g/l of VOC.
<b>Shelf life</b>	24 months when stored according to the recommended guidelines
<b>Storage</b>	In original sealed packaging between 5° and 35°C in a dry, dark environment
<b>Safety Norms</b>	This product may cause skin allergic reactions. Do not mix with other products. It is important to adhere to the prevailing safety and hygiene standards while using it. Refrain from disposing of the product in drains, water bodies, or on the ground. Always keep the product out of reach of children. <b>Application Instructions</b>	<b>APPLICATION</b> First, remove any dust from the surface and make sure that it is clean of dust. Then, spread THE CLEANER FOR VENETIAN PLASTER with a sponge or a cloth and rub it on the surface in circular movements. When the surface is still humid, remove any excess product with a clean damp cloth. Usually, one coat is enough for excellent results.
<b>Tools</b>	Sponge or cloth. Clean tools with water after use.
